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General Comments
<p>A monitoring inspection occurred in the afternoon.</p> <p>The children were observed in both the indoor and outdoor environments, including during the transition between the two. Upon arrival, the children arrived from school. Afterward, all the children transitioned outdoors.</p> <p>Both groups were observed engaging in a variety of outdoor activities, including using the stationary equipment, swinging on the swings, playing soccer, and building in the wooded area.</p> <p>Room 1: Several children were observed eating snack, with handwashing occurring beforehand. Other children engaged in free play activities such as making loom bracelets, drawing at the table, and playing with the large bouncy ball.</p> <p>Room 2: Several children were observed eating snack, with handwashing occurring beforehand. Other children engaged in free play activities, including reading books, drawing, making loom bracelets, and playing with the dollhouse and Barbies.</p> <p>The educators indicated that both groups of children are currently interested in sensory play, sliding, sports, drawing, Beyblades and making loom bracelets.</p> <p>Several forms of documentation were visible throughout both rooms, including photographs, and children's artwork. The rooms were well organized and inviting, offering a varied supply of age-appropriate materials, books, and toys.</p> <p>Educators demonstrated positive interactions by using encouraging language and gentle reminders. They asked open ended questions, listened activity, and extended children's ideas through conversations.</p> <p>A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliance. Additional documents observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, two staff files, a random review of ten child files, and monthly emergency evacuation and fire drill records.</p>
