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General Comments Licensing staff arrived at the facility at 12:30pm to conduct a Monitoring Inspection and introduce themselves as the new Quality Assurance Monitor for the licensed facility. Upon arriving, the school aged children were sitting in different areas of the classroom and engaged in "electronic time". The educator notified licensing staff that electronic time is allowed during "quiet time" where the younger children in the facility take an afternoon nap. The school aged children were observed playing on their iPad and Nintendo Switches. The educator ensured proper supervision during this time. Once it was time to transition, the educator asked the children to store their electronics in their book bags in the entrance area before cleaning up the classroom. The children were observed picking up Lego blocks, dolls, coloring pages and other play materials. The educator was observed sweeping up play material and asking the children to help clean up. Once the classroom was cleaner, the educator asked the children to quietly line up at the classroom door to go play outside. The children changed their shoes and headed to the wooded area of the property. The children were observed playing in the wooded area. A group was observed playing "man hunt" while other sat in the shelter. The educator was observed supervising the children while at play. Verbal reminders were given to the children to remain in sight and to not play in the traffic areas of the property. Licensing staff recommends frequent clean ups of the wooded area as snack wrappers and other garbage was observed on the property.
