**General Comments**

Visit to complete the renewal inspection today.

Children were observed to be actively engaged in play within each room. A great deal of smiles, laughter and happiness were noticed. The children and educators in each bubble group have been exploring interests and the topics of interest have come alive in the learning environments. Lovely displays of a variety of styles of documentation are posted and well done (songs, mark-making, creative art, learning stories, words, photos, and so on). Recommendation to reference the curriculum wheel and to make connections to the learning goals. The children have been participating in a number of activities to support and enhance their learning. Rich conversations between educators and the children were observed. This demonstrates valuing and respecting children and relationships.

Educators participated in the inspection process by contributing recent events, experiences, opportunities and routine of the day. Enthusiasm and passion for their work with children and families was clearly communicated.

Handwashing was observed upon arrival and during transitions throughout the day.
