Comments: Outside play area - standing water was observed in the Mud Kitchen, Laundry Basket, and Crab Table. To be checked and emptied, each morning, prior to play. Weeds are starting to build up in the back area, of the outside play area. The grounds shall be maintained in a clean and orderly manner and kept in a good state of repair. Weeds to be cut.

Comments: Infant Room - The top of the three level wooden stand (corner section) is damaged. To be repaired / replaced. 2/3 Room - One of the doors on the white storage cabinet was not attached. To be reattached. 4/5 Room - The Home Depot activity set, and the burners of the play stove are accumulating dust and debris. To be cleaned.			

General Comments <p>A Monitoring Inspection was completed this morning. Children were observed during both inside and outside play. Throughout the facility, children's learning was visible through several forms of documentation. For example: group and individual learning stories, photographs, and collections and samples of children's artwork. Several different learning invitations were observed throughout the facility. The infants were interested in food. Children were observed, sitting with their educators, pointing to food pictures. One of the interests in the 2/3 room was farm animals. Educators had prepared an inviting area, that included farm animals, barns, and even homemade utters, for a fine motor, pretend milking cow activity. In the 4/5 room, it was very evident that the children were interested in camping. A tent was set up, a bon fire was on display – made up of materials found in and around the classroom, and there were several books available, relating to camping and the outdoors. A table of bugs was also observed, and the table included magnifying glasses and bug themed books. In the school age room, there were several learning invitations set up, including one in the building centre, with a premade display and a note, asking the children what they could create. Children were observed creating towers, and trying to create the example creation, that was built by their educator. A new outdoor classroom was observed in the outdoor play area. Educators stated that the children have been enjoying their new outdoor classroom, and that it had been used, mainly for outdoor arts and crafts.</p>
