General Comments

A follow-up to the renewal inspection was conducted today. All orders for compliance are completed and the facility is recommended for license renewal.

The children were observed in both inside and outside play, enjoying the falling snow.

The children's learning is documented and visible throughout each of the early learning environments.

Plexiglass covered bulletin boards have been added in the rooms to display the children's learning. These are placed low on the walls and the children are able to revisit their experiences at any time.

Discussed with the operator and administrator the infant deck and to ensure that it is shoveled after each snow/ice storm. This is to ensure that extra weight isn't added to the deck where the preschool children play underneath the deck.

The environments in each of the four rooms has come alive with the children's learning. There is a wide variety of age-appropriate materials for the children to interact and engage with. The educators were observed engaged with the children, down at their level in conversations and play. Positive interactions were observed from all the educators towards the children in their care.
