General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred July 28, 2025

The children were observed engaging in a variety of activities across indoor and outdoor environments, including snack time and free play. Handwashing occurred before the transition to snack.

Infants: The children were observed eating snack, having their diapers changed, and playing outdoors on the deck. Outdoors, the children were observed sitting in the pear-shaped hanging chair looking at books, going down the slide, playing with toy cars, and playing at the water table. Educators indicated that the children currently show interest in movement, books, music, and toy cars/trucks.

Toddler Room: The children were observed waking up from nap, having their diapers changed, eating snack, and transitioning to the outdoors. The educators indicated that the children are currently showing interest in blocks, Spiderman, dinosaurs, and baby dolls.

Preschool: The children were observed engaging with puzzles and playing with playdough at the table. Outdoors, the children were observed in the mud kitchen, digging in the sandbox, and riding bikes. The educator indicated the children are currently showing interest in letters, sensory play, and outdoor play.

After School: The children were observed during snack time, free play, and transitioning to the outdoors. They were observed playing the Pac-Man machine, engaging in open-ended art, and participating in dramatic play by acting out roles in a bakery. This included a manager, baker, and security. The children created a menu and were conducting interviews. Outdoors, the children were observed building a fort out of the large waffle connecting blocks and tires.

A clearly visible and prominent area is designated for posting the facility's license, current monitoring reports, and any orders for compliances., Additional documents observed included incident logs, daily attendance records, Two new staff files, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

The diaper changing area is located within meter of a sink, supporting proper hygiene practices. Diaper changing procedures were posted and clearly visible. Diaper changing procedures were observed and followed appropriately.

A conversation took place with the educators on the following:

General Comments

- Ensuring bingo dabbers are inaccessible to the children.
- Ensuring the infant stroller tray is wiped down after use.
- Administrator to update the parent board with current Quality Assurance Monitor information.
- Preschool Room: Purposeful planning was not evident. Purposeful planning is to be visible through invitations, documentation, and planned activities. Educators are to review the Operator's Manual, Section 7: Programming and Daily Routine.
