10(1) The number of educators that are required for a group of children of mixed ages receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre is calculated as follows: (a) by multiplying the number of children of the same age by the corresponding factor set out in Schedule A; and (b) by adding the results obtained under paragraph (a). Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that one educator is supervising a group of 12 children requiring 2 educators while the second educator brought children to the bathroom and performed diaper changes. To ensure that children are properly supervised at all times, the educator must bring all children under their supervision to the bathroom with them during washroom breaks and diaper changes. During another bathroom break, the educator brought all the children for whom she was responsible for to the bathroom with them during diaper changes. The inspector also observed in another classroom that one educator is supervising a group of 17 children, 13 of which are sleeping. The child-to-staff ratio for children in a group may only be reduced by one-half for napping children when all children are asleep or resting quietly on mats. During the inspection, a second educator returned to the classroom.
