<p>Mask use for Alert orange in daycare. (p.1-2)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children under 5 years of age in early learning and childcare facilities are not required to wear a community mask within their group. However, children between 2 and 4 years old are required to wear a community mask in common areas such as corridors and bathrooms. Children must be supervised depending on the child's ability to tolerate the mask, as well as, when putting on and taking off the mask. • School-age children (4-12) in early learning and childcare facilities are required to wear a mask at all times, including within the classroom, in common spaces, and outdoors. Exceptions will be when they are working silently, eating, or in play during sports activities. • All employees of early learning and childcare facilities are required to wear a mask at all times, including outside. Exceptions will be when they are eating or sitting alone in a closed office or room.
