Comments: When the children are napping, the staff members included in the child-staff ratio must remain on site and be easily accessible in the building. The ratio is correct before my departure from the daycare.

Comments: Awaiting certificate for an educator. The other educator will register for the online course and will do her ECE in September.

Comments: Exemption request to come. The operator began her early childhood course online in May.

Comments: The play structure inside the daycare is made of wood and the bars are less than an inch apart. The slide is commercial, no protective surface. The structure is currently closed with an empty shelf in front of the steps. During my visit, no child was around the indoor play structure. The structure is not stable, it wobbles and it should be hung on the wall. Discussion with the operator of the possibility of removing the play structure from the daycare. The children were on the structure during my visit until the educator asked them to come down

Comments: The protective surface for non-commercial play equipment is not sufficient (less than 1-3 inches depending on the structure). Outdoor play structures cannot be used if they do not have the protective surface required by the manufacturer's manual. It is important to scrape for the protective surface to conform. In addition, you need to remove medium and large rocks from the protective surface.			
33(2) Stationary equipment in the outdoor play area shall be surrounded by a protective surfacing and installed according to the manufacturer's instructions.	33(2)	Jun 25, 2021	
Comments: Materials have been ordered to repair the commercial structure in the outdoor park which should not be used until it has been repaired. The protective surface for commercial play equipment is not sufficient (less than 1-3 inches depending on the structure). Outdoor play structures including swings cannot be used if they do not have the protective surface required by the CSA. It is important to scrape for the protective surface to conform. In addition, you need to remove medium and large rocks from the protective surface.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (b) medications.	39(2)(b)	Jun 02, 2021	Jun 16, 2021
Comments: Deficiency is now compliant. The medication were locked in the office. They are no longer in the white cabinet.

<p>The ratio is correct when I leave daycare. It is recommended that you contact insurance if you do not have the manufacturer's manual for the protective surface to be placed under non-commercial structures.</p>
