Comments: The play structure inside the daycare is made of wood and the bars are less than an inch apart. The slide is commercial, no protective surface. The structure is currently closed with a shelf. During my visit, no child was around the indoor play structure. The structure is not stable, it wobbles and it should be hung on the wall. Discussion with the operator of the possibility of removing the play structure from the daycare.

Comments: During my visit, the children play with all the structures. The operator has been advised that she should not let them play in structures that are not compliant. The protective surface for the play equipment is not sufficient (less than 1-3 inches depending on the structure). Outdoor play structures cannot be used if they do not have the protective surface required by the manufacturer's manual or CSA. It is important to scrape for the protective surface to conform. In addition, you need to remove medium and large rocks from the protective surface.

The protective surface for non-commercial play equipment is not sufficient (less than 1-3 inches depending on the structure). Outdoor play structures cannot be used if they do not have the protective surface required by the manufacturer's manual. It is important to scrape for the protective surface to conform. In addition, you need to remove medium and large rocks from the protective surface.</p>			

General Comments
<p>The daycare meets the requirements of the Early Childhood Services Act and New Brunswick regulation according to the ratio.  The children finish their snack (watermelon) and then go outside.  During my visit, the children play with all the structures. The operator has been advised that she should not let them play in structures that are not compliant.</p>
