Comments: Photos were taken with the modifications made to the structure. While waiting for approval, the shelf must stay in front of the structure. The play structure inside the daycare is made of wood and the bars are less than an inch apart. The slide is commercial, puzzle mats have been put in double thickness as a protective surface. The structure is not stable, it wobbles and it should be hung on the wall. Discussion with the operator of the possibility of changing the place structure in the daycare (put next to a solid wall for more stability).
