Photos were taken. The structure cannot be used by children as long as the modifications have not been made. The play structure inside the daycare is made of wood and the bars are less than an inch apart. The slide is commercial, puzzle mats have been put in double thickness as a protective surface.

The operator has been advised that she should not let them play in structures that are not compliant. The protective surface for the play equipment is not sufficient (less than 1-3 inches depending on the structure). Outdoor play structures cannot be used if they do not have the protective surface required by the manufacturer's manual or CSA.
