Comments: The upstairs area still cannot be used until the fence around the pool is fixed. It was also observed that there were paper wraps in play area ,food and toys that needs to be washed.

Comments: The Little Tikes tree house cannot be used until it is fixed to be safe for the children. Refer to fabricant Manuel instruction.

Comments: There is one toilet that is not working well. This need to be fixed as soon as possible.			

**General Comments**

The daycare meets the requirements of the Early Childhood Services Act and New Brunswick regulation according to the ratio. During my visit I have observed free play inside the daycare. I discuss with the educator that children should help by putting their trash in the garbage and not on the floor. Also, to store the toys after they played with it. This is a way to educate them to respect their environment and would also be helpful to them. I went in the afternoon I observed the children watching television and free play. They have solved the problem with the sand box.
