Comments: In the outdoor park, the 2 gates no longer close when I arrive at the daycare. When we go outside, a hockey goal has been put in front of the back gate, a strap needs to be put again. In addition, the front gate was temporarily straightened before I left, but still needs to be re-aligned to ensure the children's safety. Photos will be sent by email and another visit will take place shortly. Also, in the fenced-in children's play area, broken toys, plastic bottles, straw, pieces of plastic, etc. must be picked up and put in the garbage can.			
33(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide outdoor play area materials and equipment that are varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	33(1)	Apr 09, 2024	
Comments: Materials and equipment need to be varied and in sufficient quantity for all children present. Toys must be available so that children can play outdoors. A kitchenette without accessories, a blackboard, a truck, a rocking horse, 1 doll, 4 small cars to sit on were available at the time of my visit. The natural environment allows children to play with the pine cones, too.			
36(7) A nap mat shall be at least 5 cm in thickness and stored in a way that avoids contact with the surface of another nap mat or disinfected on both sides after each use.	36(7)	Apr 09, 2024	
Comments: The nap mats need to be cleaned before and after each use, or stored separately so there is no contact with another nap mat. In addition, there is a stain on one of them. A photo will be sent to me when the nap mat will be cleaned.			

<b>General Comments</b>  During my visit in the morning, the daycare meets the requirements of the Early Childhood Services Act and New Brunswick regulation according to the ratio, the diaper changing and washrooms. The children go outside during my visit.
