The gate in the outdoor play area was secured before the children went outside (4:15pm).

Discussion with the educator and the operator about the upstairs room (they inform me that the room is no longer in use, as it is being renovated). I informed them of the maximum number of children allowed in the large room downstairs (20 spaces). They need to send me an application of change.

Follow-up of the public health inspector report was discussed. The storage space cannot be used as a sleeping area
