Comments: A check of the daily attendance records for staff and children for the weeks of October 7-11 and October 14-18. The number of children varies between 25-30 on the attendance sheets with school-age children. When I checked the daily children's records, I was told that the data was wrong, and they corrected it before I left. The data is still over 20. Don't forget that if the room upstairs isn't available, you can't exceed 20 children at the same time. I request that copied of the register be sent by e-mail for the coming weeks of October 21-25 and October 28- November 1st.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (j) smoke alarm, smoke detector and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records.	24(1)(j)	Oct 18, 2024	
Comments: In the upstairs room, the fire extinguisher no longer hangs on the wall, the emergency light has been unplugged from the walls and the fire alarm beeps during my visit, as it needs a new battery. Following contact with the fire marshal, he agrees to the lighting being unplugged as long as the premises are not used by children, although a battery must be installed in the smoke detector.			
28(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall not change the allocation of space used to provide services or add to or alter any building or facility or any part of them unless the Minister has approved the changes in writing.	28(1)	Oct 21, 2024	
Comments: I was informed that the room upstairs was being renovated and was not accessible to children. An application of change needs to be done. For the moment, a maximum of 20 children can be in the daycare at the same time. The number will be reduced from 24 to 20 until the renovations are complete in the upstairs room.

Comments: Small beads (around 1 to 3 mm) accessible to children under 3 years old. The beads have been put out of reach has requested.			
33(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide outdoor play area materials and equipment that are varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	33(1)	Oct 25, 2024	
Comments: The outdoor play materials have been reduced since the summer. There must be enough play materials for the number of children enrolled. A photo will be sent to me when the additions are made.			
34(2) Access to a private pool with a filtration and chlorination system by a child receiving services at a licensed facility is permitted in the following circumstances: (b) the pool is enclosed with a fence at least 1.52 m in height in addition to the fence enclosing the outdoor play area.	34(2)(b)	Oct 21, 2024	
Comments: The pool must be enclosed with a fence. Some parts of the fence have been removed. This need to be repair. The upstairs room cannot be used until the pool is a fence.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Oct 17, 2024	Oct 17, 2024
Comments: The following products (Vim, Lysol and a sanitizing gel - 1 gal) are in the bathroom were high up, but not locked. The products were locked away at my request.			
39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (b) medications.	39(2)(b)	Oct 17, 2024	Oct 17, 2024
Comments: The medication (tynenol syrup with syringe) was in the bathroom in the child's storage space on top of the diaper-changing mattress. The medication was locked up at my request.			

General Comments
<p>During my visit in the afternoon, the daycare meets the requirements of the Early Childhood Services Act and New Brunswick regulation, according to the ratio.</p> <p>Observation of the afterschool arrivals and the snack provided by the daycare (soft bars).</p> <p>The gate in the outdoor play area was secured before the children went outside (4:15pm).</p> <p>Discussion with the educator and the operator about the upstairs room (they inform me that the room is no longer in use, as it is being renovated). I informed them of the maximum number of children allowed in the large room downstairs (20 spaces). They need to send me an application of change.</p> <p>Follow-up of the public health inspector report was discussed. The storage space cannot be used as a sleeping area.</p> <p>The dome play equipment outside the outdoor play area is used only by the owner's children.</p>
