General Comments

Follow-up inspection on November 26, 2025, in the morning.
During my visit, the staff-to-child ratio was compliant. There were no children under the age of two present. I observed free play activities, coloring, and the snack brought from home by the children. The children did not go outside as it was raining this morning. In addition, most of the children did not have clothing suitable for the

weather. The educator reminded parents to provide winter clothing for outdoor play.
A review of professional development hours was conducted, but proof of training is missing. The educators and the administrator will need to provide proof of completed training.
The criminal record check (vulnerable sector) and the D.S. file verification must also be sent by email before mid-December.
We then discussed the documents that still need to be submitted for the renewal request. The documents can be sent by email
