<p><b>General Comments</b></p> <p>During my unplanned visit in the morning, I observed compliance with the ratio. The majority of the children are absent due to hand, foot and mouth disease. Furthermore, no young children under the age of 2 are present. The following elements are observed during my visit:  Medications are stored in a locked cabinet and kept out of children's reach. No administration was required. The indoor play area is clean, safe, and has exposure to natural light.  The indoor play materials are varied, available in sufficient quantity for the number of children present, and stored on low, open shelves that are easily accessible.  Observation of handwashing and snacks provided by parents.  In conclusion, new posters on communicable diseases were distributed during my monitoring inspection. A total of three packets, each containing three posters, was provided.  The posters covered the following topics:  - Rashes, skin lesions, and itching in children  - Diarrhea in children  - Respiratory symptoms in children</p>
