General Comments						
Children were just arriving from school when I arrived for today's renewal inspection. One group went directly						

Educators with the group outside were observed interacting with children at time of inspection. They were also observed redirecting children when needed. Educators bring children inside in two groups so that they have more room to get their winter gear off. Upon coming inside for snack, educators ensured that all children washed their hands before sitting down to eat. Children were observed playing freely around the room at end of day.

The group that had stayed inside first were observed playing freely around the room after they had snack. Educators from this group also ensured children washed their hands before grabbing their lunchboxes. Children and educator were observed playing a game of "George the pickle" before getting ready to go play outside. Once they returned inside, children were observed playing group games with their educator until end of inspection.

All educators were observed being attentive and interacting with children at time of inspection.

outside to play while the second group stayed in to have snack and to play.

It is recommended that "circle time" for the group located in the classroom closest to the playground be reviewed, as it appeared to be a bit chaotic for both the educator and children.

A reminder to educators that animals are not permitted in the Early Learning and Childcare Facility unless all Public Health guidelines are followed. These guidelines can be in the "Guidelines for the Prevention and Control
