General Comments						
Upon licensing staff's arrival for the annual renewal inspection, the first group of children was arriving from the Go-Go bus, accompanied by educators. As the children entered the facility, they placed their belongings in their designated cubbies. The group then gathered in a circle where the educator introduced the planned craft activity for the day and explained the afternoon's routine. Children were able to eat their snacks freely at cleaned tables or engage in free play. Shortly after, the second group of children arrived from the Go-Go bus, stored their belongings, and joined a circle meeting. The educator reviewed the Go-Go rules and reminded them about the upcoming community "Trunk or Treat" event on Sunday. Children were then given the option to eat their snacks or participate in						
activities. Once snacks were finished, tables were cleaned. Some children chose to complete the craft activity, which involved tracing their hands and creating Halloween-themed artwork.						
Throughout both groups, educators were observed engaging positively with the children. This included playing chess, tic-tac-toe, reading or participating in craft activities. Other children played independently or with peers in various areas, including blocks, dramatic play, toy trucks, reading and LEGO.						
Later in the afternoon, the educator from one of the groups gave a 5-minute warning to clean up. After the group cleaned up, they transitioned onto the matt for reading time. The educator let a child who guessed the number they had in their head pick the book for the educator to read to the group. Due to the rain, the groups spent the afternoon indoors.						
Only positive child guidance was observed during the visit. Staff and child files were verified. Fire evacuation drills were completed monthly.						
Licensing staff recommends the facility for renewal.
