Comments: The most recent Renewal Inspection Report has not been posted. Administrator must ensure that this report is posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (j) smoke alarm, smoke detector and fire extinguisher inspection and maintenance records.	24(1)(j)	Mar 15, 2022	
Comments: During the second Follow-Up Inspection, smoke alarm, smoke detector and fire extinguisher inspections and maintenance records could not be provided to the Inspector. A third conversation was had with the Administrator regarding that these checks be completed and documented.			
24(1) For the purposes of subsection 20(1) of the Act, the following records and documents shall be maintained on the premises of a licensed facility: (l) management of potential illness forms provided by the Minister.	24(1)(l)	Feb 28, 2022	
Comments: The Management of potential illness forms could not be provided to the Inspector while on-site. A third conversation was had with the Administrator indicating that copies of these forms must be kept in the facility in order for them to be used when necessary.			
24(2) The records and documents referred to in subsection (1) shall be maintained for at least one year after the record or document is made.	24(2)	Mar 15, 2022	
Comments: Management of potential illness forms as well as smoke alarm, smoke detector and fire extinguisher inspections and maintenance records must be maintained on-site. Administrator must ensure that all administrative records are maintained for a year on-site.			
28(3) The premises of a licensed facility shall comply with (a) lighting, ventilation and other general health standards under the Public Health Act.	28(3)(a)	Jul 12, 2022	Jul 19, 2022
Comments: During the second Follow-Up Inspection, Inspector observed that there was toilet paper in both washrooms designated for children. However, there was no paper towels in the towel dispenser to dry their hands in one of the washrooms. This was added to the washroom while Inspector was on-site. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: Toxic products were under lock and key while Inspector was on-site. Deficiency is now compliant			
41(1) A licensed facility at which services are provided to children who wear diapers shall have a sturdy surface that is (b) covered with a non-absorbent layer.	41(1)(b)	Feb 28, 2022	
Comments: A changing surface has been provided for diaper changing. However, because there are tears on the changing surface, it is no longer covered with a non-absorbent layer. Administrator must purchase a new changing surface that is covered with a non-absorbent layer and that is used exclusively for diaper changing.			
41(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall (a) post diaper-changing procedures in diaper-changing areas.	41(3)(a)	Feb 28, 2022	
Comments: The diaper changing procedures have not been posted. A third conversation was had with the Administrator that the diaper changing procedures must be posted in the diaper changing area and that these procedures must be followed.
