12(3) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that a criminal record check or a vulnerable sector check, as the case may, and a check with the Department of Social Development is conducted on each staff member and associated person at least every five years.	12(3)	Jan 17, 2023	
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that a criminal record check is still missing in the 11 employee files verified. The administrator informed the inspector that the employee's name was misspelled and that a new request was made with the RCMP. During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that all employees have a check with social development.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed a calendar which displayed purposely planned activities. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed the children dancing indoor and outdoor free play. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that a staff signed statement regarding obligations under the Act and licensing regulation is present in all employee files. Deficiency is now compliant.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that 2 out of the 11 employees verified did not have a valid check with Social Development. During the inspection, the administrator was able to confirm that the checks with Social Development had been completed by showing the inspector a copy on their phone. The operator must place a copy of the checks in the employees' files.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that 9 plastic baskets had been placed on the gym floor for children to store their personal belongings while the other children stored their bookbags, lunches boxes and outdoor wear in piles on the gym floor. The operator must ensure that all children have easily accessible space to store their personal belongings.			
40(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall ensure that personal belongings of a child receiving services at the licensed facility that are brought to the licensed facility, including combs, brushes, toothbrushes, towels, washcloths, bedding, pacifiers and soothers, are (c) stored separately for each child.	40(1)(c)	Jan 16, 2023	
Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the inspector observed that 9 plastic baskets had been placed on the gym floor for children to store their personal belongings while the other children stored their bookbags, lunches boxes and outdoor wear in piles on the gym floor. The operator must ensure that personal belongings are stored separately for each child.

Comments: During the follow-up inspection, the administrator advised the inspector that a first aid kit and phone are accessible and will be brought on each outing. Deficiency is now compliant.
