Administrator indicates that they received verbal consent from the parent that this outing is permitted. However, written consent must be obtained. Administrator filled out required form during the inspection and the parent's signature was obtained during the inspection.								
	Inspector had a discussion with the administrator, who indicates that they bring the children to the public pool during the summer months. When Inspector asked to see the consent forms, Inspector was advised that they are currently at the Operator's other facility. Administrator must ensure that these consents are brought back to the facility and placed in the children's records.

As per the Operator Manual (page 75), the outdoor play area is an extension of the indoor play environment, providing many of the same opportunities, including space for creative, quiet, pretend and sensory experiences. Recommendation that Administrator consult the Operator Manual (page 169), for suggested materials and equipment for the outdoor play area.

During the renewal inspection, Inspector observed the children arriving to the facility from school, indoor free play, outdoor play as well as the snack.								
Administrator must ensure that the Inspector's contact information is up to date on the parent board, and that the previous Inspector and Quality Assurance Monitor's information be removed.								
Inspector observed that the emergency evacuation procedures are posted in a visible and prominent place in the facility. However, the instructions of what to do in case of an emergency are faded and difficult to read. Inspector recommends that this information be re-written to be easier to read.
