Comments: At the time of the inspection, the Quality Assurance Monitor observed a cup of coffee in the gym. Hot beverages are not permitted in area occupied by children. The administrator on site immediately disposed the coffee. Deficiency is now compliant

Comments: While taking ratios, one educator told the Quality Assurance Monitor that 18 children were present. Another educator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that 20 children were present; however, 21 children were signed in on the attendance sheet. With that, 21 children are present at the time of the inspection. To ensure appropriate supervision, educator must know how many children are in their care at all times. Deficiency is now compliant
