9(1) The child-to-staff ratio is one educator for each of the following groups of children of the same age receiving services at a full-time or part-time early learning and childcare centre: (a) three infants or fewer; (b) five children or fewer who are two years of age; (c) eight children or fewer who are three years of age; (d) ten children or fewer who are four years of age or older, but who are not yet attending school; and (e) 15 school-age children or fewer.

Comments:

While taking ratios, one educator told the Quality Assurance Monitor that 18 children were present. Another educator informed the Quality Assurance Monitor that 20 children were present; however, 21 children were signed in on the attendance sheet. With that, 21 children are present at the time of the inspection. To ensure appropriate supervision, educator must know how many children are in their care at all times. Deficiency is now compliant
