Comments: During the renewal inspection, inspector asked an educator to see that the daily activities are purposely planned and documented. Educator provides a calendar with a few activities indicated. Operator must ensure that daily activities involve engaging the children and reflecting on the children's interest, passions, strengths and abilities.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (a) varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	32(1)(a)	May 22, 2025	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed that the indoor play area lacked a sufficient quantity of materials and equipment for all children present. The available materials were not arranged in a manner that supports free choice and a variety of activity types. The operator must ensure that the indoor play area is adequately equipped with a diverse and sufficient range of materials and equipment to meet the needs of all children.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (b) arranged on low, open shelves and accessible to the children receiving services at the licensed facility,	32(1)(b)	May 22, 2025	May 07, 2025
Comments: Inspector is onsite for a re visit and the indoor play material has been removed from the closed cabinet and placed them in an open shelf. Deficiency is now compliant			
48(2) An operator of a licensed facility may supply food to a child receiving services at the licensed facility that a parent or guardian of the child brings from the child's home if the food is labelled with the child's name and refrigerated, as required.	48(2)	May 22, 2025	
Comments: During the renewal inspection, the inspector observed children eating their snacks. Of the 11 lunch boxes verified, 4 were not labeled with the child's name. The operator must ensure that all food brought from home is clearly labeled with the child's name.

Inspector is onsite to complete the renewal inspection during a re visit. Inspector observes children arrive from school and eat their snacks.
