The administrator explains that the employee has completed the renewal training; however, a copy of the updated certificate was not yet placed in the file. Comments: Inspector verifies the monthly emergency evacuation and fire drills and observes that none were completed for the month of August, September and October. It is recommended to the administrator that 2 separate emergency evacuation and fire drills be completed before the end of November. Operator must ensure emergency evacuation and fire drills are completed monthly to maintain preparedness and to ensure the children's safety.
