39(2) A licensed facility shall have a separate locked storage space that is inaccessible to the children for each of the following: (a) toxic products, chemical products and cleaning supplies;	39(2)(a)	Jul 22, 2021	
Comments: Inspector found 3 aerosol air fresheners, and one can of Invisible All Around Lubricant, which are all toxic products and must be kept locked with a key. This was unlocked at the beginning of inspection and was locked later in the afternoon. First Aid Kits containing Epi-pens were found in a backpack on the floor. First aid kits contain toxic products which must be stored out of the reach of children. Epi-Pens must also be stored out of the reach of children (while still being accessible in case of emergency).			
39(3) Despite paragraph (2)(b), medications administered in cases of anaphylactic shock shall not be stored in a locked space.	39(3)	Jul 23, 2021	
Comments: Epi-Pens are kept in first aid kits, but during inspection First aid kits were left on different floors of the building, and were not with the children. These first aid kits, and therefore the epi pens, were also not kept out of the reach of children. All epi pens must be easily accessible but stored out of the reach of children.
