Comments: During a routine review of child record files, it was noted that the city portion of the address was missing for both emergency contacts listed. As per licensing requirements, each child record must include the full name, complete address (including city), and phone number of at least two emergency contacts. This information is essential for licensing staff to verify that emergency contacts are located at least one hour away from the facility. The address was added immediately to the files in question. Deficiency is now compliant

The Quality Assurance Monitor is on site for a monitoring Inspection. The followings were verified: - Posting - Child records - Incident records - Daily activities - Indoor play area All incidents are properly recorded, documented, and signed by parents to ensure they are fully informed of any occurrences involving their child while at the facility. Additionally, all required documents are posted in a visible and prominent location within the facility, supporting transparency and keeping parents well-informed about day-to-day operations. During the inspection, child-to-staff ratios were respected. Children were observed playing indoors and transitioning to outdoor play.
