| Comments: Some aspects of Covid-19 procedures were not followed. Covid-19 screening was not completed at the door. Inspector was asked to sign visitor's log midway through inspection. Cleaning logs are being kept. Infant mattress in gym has rips and is no longer non absorbant. Must be removed. Inspector notes it is used for play not napping. | | | |

General Comments

Fencing in both preschool and infant area has spacing in some places which would allow a child to climb underneath the fence. This may be due to erosion. This must be repaired. Operator to advise Inspector on plan.

Inspector observed children playing outside during inspection.

Preschoolers had been offsite at time of inspection on a trip to a local park. They returned at end of inspection.
