Comments: In one room there was an electrical outlet missing a protective receptacle cover. Was corrected during the inspection. Deficiency is now compliant.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (a) varied and in sufficient quantity for the number and ages of the children receiving services at the licensed facility.	32(1)(a)	Nov 25, 2022	
Comments: In one room there are only 6 books, this is not a sufficient quantity for the 9 children in attendance. A sufficient quantity of materials and equipment ensures the availability of enough play resources, avoids excessive competition and long waits for children. Operator must provision all rooms with a sufficient quantity of play materials. New items are to be added regularly to ensure that children are provided with new learning opportunities.			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (b) arranged on low, open shelves and accessible to the children receiving services at the licensed facility,	32(1)(b)	Nov 14, 2022	Nov 24, 2022
Comments: Deficiency is now compliant			
32(1) An operator of a licensed facility shall provide indoor play area materials and equipment that are (d) clean and in good repair.	32(1)(d)	Nov 25, 2022	
Comments: In one room 5 of the 6 books are ripped. In each of the other rooms there are 2-4 books that are in disrepair. The Operator must ensure that children have access to well-maintained materials. Books that are ripped will be repaired and/or replaced daily.			
36(4) The rest area of a full-time early learning and childcare centre and an early learning and childcare home shall allow for a space of at least 46 cm between each crib, portable playpen, cot or nap mat.	36(4)	Nov 14, 2022	
Comments: Not observed in one room as the nap equipment is on order. In another room the cots are being placed too close together. The QA Monitor suggests that the educators use a ruler to familiarize themselves with how far apart 46 cm is. All mats must be placed at least 46 cm apart.			
36(6) A cot, a nap mat or the mattress of a crib or portable playpen shall be washable and non-absorbent or covered with a non-absorbent layer.	36(6)	Nov 14, 2022	
Comments: Not observed as the nap equipment is on order.
