Comments: In one room there are only 6 books, this is not a sufficient quantity for the 9 children in attendance A sufficient quantity of materials and equipment ensures the availability of enough play resources, avoids excessive competition and long waits for children. Operator must provision all rooms with a sufficient quantity of play materials. New items are to be added regularly to ensure that children are provided with new learning opportunities.

Comments: In one room 5 of the 6 books are ripped. In each of the other rooms there are 2-4 books that are in disrepair. The Operator must ensure that children have access to well-maintained materials. Books that are ripped will be repaired and/or replaced daily.

Comments: Not observed in one room as the nap equipment is on order. In another room the cots are being placed too close together. The QA Monitor suggests that the educators use a ruler to familiarize themselves with how far apart 46 cm is. All mats must be placed at least 46 cm apart.
