Quality Assurance Monitor observed children being welcomed to the center by staff upon arrival, washing hands							
for snack, gathering their lunchboxes, eating their snack, freeplay, reading books, circle time with interactive							
story games and singing, and preparation for outdoor play.							
QAM observed positive child guidance when an educator was comforting a child who spilled their water; educators were supportive with children as they prepared for outdoor play.							
QAM notes that one room was closed for the day and children divided into other rooms due to low ratio.							
Quality Assurance Monitor notes that the 2 year old room which had been divided into two rooms is now one							
large room. There are small shelves which provide some division but children are able to pass freely through the room.
