### General Comments

Quality Assurance Monitor observed preschool and toddler rooms. Rooms were clean and materials were plentiful and developmentally appropriate. Learning stories were posted with pictures of the children engaged in several activities. These stories were up to date and recent and provided evidence of engaging programming and activities taking place on a consistent basis.

Licensing staff observed as children were transitioning to outdoor play. Rooms could benefit from a stronger routine for getting ready to go outside. Song/stories and a more defined area to stand or sit could help improve

their current routine and help it progress more quickly.

Positive behaviour guidance was observed, however staff should focus on redirection, focusing on positive behaviour, modeling appropriate behaviour and offering choices whenever possible to strengthen these skills and support children who are exhibiting challenging behaviours.

The outdoor play area contained many wooden materials, all children were engaged in self-directed play and enjoyed gross motor activities during their outdoor time. Children were dress appropriately for the colder weather.
