<p>General Comments</p> <p>Upon the arrival of Nancy Glendenning and Melika Belliveau, some of the children were finishing up snack, some were playing, and others were outside or preparing to go outside.</p> <p>In the children's spaces, materials for sensory play, books, dramatic play, blocks, art, doll houses and multicultural dolls, big lego, sensory bins, cars, a busy board, and soft toys were observed. One of the classrooms appears to need more support and the administrator stated that they are working on it. More shelving may be required. Educators should use the NB curriculum to support the children's environment. Materials should be accessible to children at their level.</p> <p>There are many pictures and learning stories. Pictures of the children's learning experiences and their families are posted. Educators are journaling, webbing and posting the children's artwork on the walls.</p> <p>This facility has grasped natural elements in the outdoor play space. There are wooden tables, balance beams. and trees. As it is early Spring, not all accessories were in the outdoor play space, but they do have an abundance in storage. The outdoor play space has a wooden storage where paper and writing utensils and books can be stored. The educators were engaging with the children at their level and also blowing bubbles and playing games. Please ensure that there is surfacing on both sides of the slide in the back playground once the ground is unfrozen and the ground becomes dry.</p> <p>Potential illness forms, attendance records, incident forms, infant / toddler sheets and medication records are being filled out properly. Fire drills are also being conducted and recorded. Licensing staff were able to verify all documentation required to meet regulations.</p> <p>I can now recommend facility for licensing pending a current health inspection.</p>
