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| <p>The purpose of this visit was to follow-up on the non-compliances for the outdoor play space. Both the preschool and infant play spaces have been made to be an extension of the indoor play space. As you enter the outdoor play space, you can identify many learning centres with materials in them. All broken materials and furnishings have been removed from the space. The stairs and ramp have been replaced and the piece of metal that was hanging over the door way has been removed.</p> <p>The infant space included materials but was not limited to a sandy area, blocks, cars, ride on vehicles, a slide, a kitchen with accessories, a play tent, a music wall, and the turf has also been replaced. The administrator stated that the educators continuously bring materials from inside to the outside as well.</p> <p>The preschool / school-age area includes a very large art area, a music wall, a basket ball net, a bucket of balls, loose parts, mud kitchens with accessories, sand, a construction area, and sensory area. On the fence, pictures of the town of Woodstock were also posted. The administrator stated that the areas are not yet complete and one of the things that they plan to do is add a garden area.</p> <p>The changes made are noticeable and child centered. I can now recommend facility for licensing pending a current health inspection.</p> |
