Comments: The Quality Assurance Monitor verified that daily activities were intentionally planned and documented for school age group; however, one of the school-age groups did not demonstrate consistent purposeful planning and documentation. The operator must ensure that all daily activities are intentionally planned, documented, and responsive to the capabilities, needs, and interests of each child.			
50(2) The operator of a licensed facility shall inform the parent or guardian of a child involved in an incident on the day the incident takes place and shall ensure that the parent or guardian signs the daily log to confirm their awareness.	50(2)	Feb 13, 2026	
Comments: While reviewing four incident logs from four different child records, it was observed that one incident log had not been signed by the parent. The administrator must ensure that all incident logs are signed by parents or guardians prior to being filed.

During the monitoring inspection, it was observed that the administrator had not updated the board with the new Quality Assurance Monitor's information; however, the previous mentor's information was still posted. The Quality Assurance Monitor had a discussion with the administrator that the new Mentor's information must be updated and posted as soon as possible. The Quality Assurance Monitor will verify on her next monitoring inspection.
