### General Comments

A Monitoring Inspection occurred July 21, 2025

The children were observed engaging in a variety of outdoor activities, including playing with a basketball, coloring, building with Lego, and climbing on the tires. Educators indicated that the children currently show interest in sports, bugs, jump rope, and coloring/drawing.

Several forms of documentation were visible in the indoor environment, including photographs, children's artwork, and a flower-themed learning web.

The rooms were well-organized and inviting, with a varied supply of age-appropriate materials, books, and toys. A clearly visible and prominent area was designated for posting the facility license, current monitoring reports, and any compliance orders. Additional documents observed included incident logs, three new staff files, and records of evacuation and monthly fire drills.

Toxic products, such as chemical products and cleaners, were locked and inaccessible to the children.

A conversation took place with the Administrator on the following:

Educators to ensure that no garbage is left in the outdoor play area.

### Recommendation:

To enhance the outdoor play environment and support children's interest in active play, it is recommended to add a variety of sports materials. Suggested materials include:

- Basketball nets
- Balls in various sizes (e.g., soccer balls, tennis balls)
- Baseball bats, balls, and gloves
- Badminton and tennis rackets, along with nets
- Floor hockey sticks and nets

General Comments

- Cones for games and obstacle courses
- Outdoor games such as bowling, croquet, ring toss, and horseshoes
- Hula hoops and parachutes for group activities
