- \*2 classes of school age children today during my visit. They spent much of their morning outdoors. The humidity will be very high in the afternoon, so they are taking advantage of spending some time outside. \*Groups logs change daily, hence educators are tracking this daily. I recommend that group logs are completed first thing in the AM, as children arrive and continue adding children's names. It would be recommended that Parents advise the operator weekly the days their children will be in attendance so educators can complete their daily log ahead of time.
- \*As stated above please ensure that parents have provided the household contact list. This must be stored in all child files.
- \*Based on my observation the Centre is following appropriate Covid -19 procedures cleaning schedules are visible and completed several times throughout the day.
- \*Educators are tracking the required administration files and all is up to date. No incidents to report since
