General Comments					

Upon licensing staff arrival, children were observed engaged in play with sensory bins they had created alongside their educator. These bins featured a variety of materials, including rice, toy butterflies, bugs, and grass. As snack time approached, the children worked together to clean up, guided by the educator's words of encouragement. After cleaning, the children sat down to eat their snack, following proper handwashing procedures beforehand.

Throughout the classroom, various displays of children's play were visible, showcasing documentation of their activities, Easter-themed projects, and numerous photos of the children at play. The tables were set up with invitations to engage in different activities, offering a range of age-appropriate materials. There were designated areas for dramatic play, arts, and reading, supporting a variety of interests and developmental needs.

After finishing their snack, the children transitioned outdoors, where they played in a sandpit before exploring the play structure, complete with a zip line. The part-time preschoolers played outside until they were picked up to go home.

When the after-school children arrived, they were greeted by educators outside. Attendance was taken, and the children came inside to wash their hands before enjoying a snack. Afterwards, they returned outdoors to play for the remainder of the day.

The playground was equipped with a variety of materials, including art supplies, a play kitchen, a climbing structure, and a sandpit.
