General Comments
Licensing Staff arrived at the facility to conduct a Monitoring Inspection. Upon arrival the children were sitting together at a large table eating morning snack. As the children finished eating, lunch boxes were packed into their bookbags and hands were washed. The indoor environment was organized and welcoming. Soft lighting was observed throughout the classroom by lamps and string lights. As the children finished eating morning snack, they were observed stacking long pieces of cardboard to create their own catapult. The children carefully placed a colorful slinky on one end while taking turns jumping on the other end. Other children took a large wooden board and used it as a car ramp, and observing different materials going down the ramp such as cars, trucks and balls. Once all the children were finished eating, an Educator filled a large sensory table with colored water, boats, cups and sponges. Throughout the morning the children freely explored the classroom and different activities such as floor puzzles, reading books and dancing. Due to the cold temperatures outside, the children stayed indoors this morning. During the time they typically would go outside before getting picked up, they were observed working together using blankets, pillows and clips to build a fort. Staff and child profiles were reviewed during today's Monitoring Inspection. The files were easily accessed and contained all required documents. Attendance records and incident reports were also reviewed today. Please ensure positive child guidance techniques are being followed through modelling desired behavior and positive phrasing such as "Let's use our walking feet" vs "stop running".
