## **General Comments**

Annual Renewal Inspection Completed.

Upon licensing staff's arrival, children were listening to stories and having their diapers changed. Both educators followed the children's lead with the story and took time to discuss what the children were pointing at.

The children are familiar with the routine and transitions were calm. There was lots of communication between staff. Teamwork was evident in the efficient completion of tasks, and this contributed to the smooth routine.

Throughout the inspection, the educators continuously sang with the children and spoke with them on their level to support their learning and extend their play. Moments like diapering, putting on shoes, going to the outdoor play space, and waiting for lunch were used to expand and develop language. Lots of rich conversations and a strong relationship between educators and children was observed.

Licensing staff heard comments like:

"It is okay, I can help you with that."

"Do you need help?"

"Yes, that is your nose. Where are your ears?"

"Yes, that is my shoulder. Can you show me your shoulder?"

Educators were nurturing, used calm and kind tones, and attended to the needs of the children. Time was provided for children to practice independence- putting on shoes and eating their lunch. When children became upset or needed assistance with sharing or navigating their feelings, staff used positive children guidance techniques.

Both indoor and outdoor environments were clean, well-maintained and had a variety of accessible materials for children to choose from. A communication board is near the entrance to inform parents of events and what children's interests have been. Family photos, process art and learning stories were also posted in the facility.

During lunch both educators had a chair to sit with children. If children were unhappy with their lunch, the

educators offered calm reassurance, named the foods and se children to ease into lunch and begin eating.	et the food out slowly. Ample time was given for
