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General Comments Licensing staff arrived in the morning to conduct a monitoring visit. The inside play area and the outside play area are well set up for the children's use. The outside play area is fenced in, has a raised wooden pergola with steps on one side and a ramp on the other and shade sails over another part of the play area. It has a covered sand box, small play climber, mud kitchen, water tables, ride on vehicles, a wagon, toy box, a bench for sitting and pea gravel. The toy box has a variety of dishes, bowls, baby dolls and other loose parts toys. The indoor play area is cool, clean and organized and it is set up in a way that allows the environment to be the third teacher. They have a cozy area with a small tent and cushioning, tables, books, a turtle sand box with balls in it and nice family photos grouped around a sign that read "Family is everything". Learning stories are posted and refer back to sections of the curriculum. Their recent visit from beekeepers and their bees was documented and very interesting to read about. The sleep area is separate with a half door so that the infants can be easily supervised. They have sufficient strollers for the children enrolled and often walk their neighbourhood. All their necessary postings were on the parent board, and they also post the First aid certificates of staff. The infant/toddler daily information forms and attendance were completed and available as was the first aid kit. The daily routine and schedule is relaxed and calm. Transitions took place smoothly and staff were engaged, kind and patient with the children. They comforted and played with the children throughout the morning, and all child guidance was positive.
