General Comments
During the renewal inspection, the preschool group went for a walk in the morning and played outside. Inspector observed lunch time, nap time and free play. Afterschool children were playing table games.
Inspector reminded operator that the protective surface (pea gravel) in the outdoor playground should be raked weekly to ensure proper depth is maintained. Protective surfacing is required for any stationary climbing structures regardless of height.
