Comments: A play mat in the preschool room is ripped, the educator said that they have ordered a new one, but it hasn't arrived yet. Inspector asked the educator to remove the mat from the classroom even though the new one hasn't arrived yet. The educator removed the play mat from the classroom. Deficiency is now compliant.			
41(2) Despite subsection (1), a changing mat used exclusively for diaper changing may be used as a surface for diaper changing for children who are at least 15 months of age.	41(2)	May 12, 2023	
Comments: There is no changing mat available for changing diapers. Equipment must be available if needed.  As per the Licensing Regulation – Early Childhood Services Act:  41(1) A licensed facility at which services are provided to children who wear diapers shall have a sturdy surface that is (a) equipped with rails or safety straps, (b) covered with a non-absorbent layer, (c) located separately from the food preparation area and not used for serving food, and (d) no more than one metre from a sink.  41(2) Despite subsection (1), a changing mat used exclusively for diaper changing may be used as a surface for diaper changing for children who are at least 15 months of age.			

General Comments
Inspector attended the facility on May 8, 2023, to complete the renewal inspection, the facility was closed on that day for preschool children. The licensing team needs to be informed when the facility is closing for the day.
Inspector returned to the facility on May 10, 2023, to complete the renewal inspection. Children were outside playing when the inspector arrived on-site. Inspector observed lunch time, nap time and the afterschool children during snack time.
Inspector informed operator that proof of professional hours for staff members that it applies for should be available on-site.
