Public Health Requirements due to Covid-19 regarding, screening, postings, cleaning, etc. being followed throughout facility.
A balance of indoor and outdoor activities observed during monitoring inspection. Educators observed to be attentive, responsive and engaged with children.
Discussed with operator her concerns regarding not having enough materials available for children in the play space. Discussed ways educators could identify if children did not have enough to engage or interest them including an increase in challenging behaviours, or not having enough materials for the amount of children who wanted to play in a particular area. Operator reports that this has not been an issue. Also discussed ways to switch out materials, add materials in to the play space when items are removed for cleaning throughout the day and providing individual containers for children with their names for use of some materials (i.e art materials,
