Comments: Proof of enrollment in mandatory 90-hour training was observed in staff member's file. Deficiency is now compliant.			

General Comments
<p>A follow up inspection occurred today. All orders for compliance were completed and the facility is recommended for license renewal.</p> <p>Inspector discussed with the Administrators Supervision 8.1.4 in the Operator's Manual where it states. "To ensure that children are appropriately supervised at all times, the child-to-staff ratio must be maintained at all times (even nap time) for children younger than 15 months of age. It was observed in Owlet's Room (0-14month) during nap time one Educator with 5 children. When Inspector addressed with Administrator, and additional Educator was added to this room.</p> <p>Discussions with two Educators in the outside play area occurred regarding ratio and two rooms. Educators indicated that they had an outside ratio which was different then an inside ratio. Children could be added as long as it did not exceed maximum group size for two educators. However, when each of the educator was asked how many children they had on their attendance sheet, one educator was over max group size for one educator and one educator was under.</p> <p>Discussed with Educators to think of it as if you have to evacuate the building. You are responsible for the children on your attendance record. If that is more than what is permitted for one educator, then you are over ratio.</p> <p>When Educator's bring children, who are not napping, to the outside to the fenced in play area where other Educators and children are, Educators are to ensure that on their attendance sheet, when they add the children, it does not put them over ratio. It may be that the children are added to another Educators attendance. If that does not permit, then an additional educator would be added to one of the groups to ensure max group size/ratio is respected at all times.</p>
