General Comments

Children were engaged in a number of different purposefully planned invitations and lessons this morning.

The snack table was prepared with placemats so children could choose to eat when they wanted and other children could continue with their activities.

Educators moved about the rooms engaging with children and providing supervision in all spaces.

Each room had a number of shelves and areas with a large variety of accessible, high-quality materials for the children to choose from and additional items were set out to reflect the current topics being taught. There was a small habitat with caterpillars. The children showed licensing staff the caterpillars and explained that they are getting bigger each day and will turn into Painted Lady Butterflies. In that area there were books and other literacy materials to expand on butterflies and insects.

Some children were diligently working on the Pink Tower and Thousand Chain. When completing the lesson, educators shared in celebration on the children's successes and accomplishments.

Child guidance was observed to be kind, compassionate and at the children's level at all times. Educators took ample time to re-direct children, speak with them about choices and expectations.

Staff files were checked and verified.

General Comments

Monthly checklists are being completed each month and recorded.

The centre, including furnishings and materials were clean, well-maintained, organized and allowed for a calm and peaceful atmosphere. The choice of soft lighting and the use of a singing bowl also contributed to a tranquil experience for the children.

Children had circle time before going outside to the outdoor play space. The transition to this time appeared smooth and children were familiar with the routine.

The outdoor play space included a well-stocked wooden play kitchen and when children showed interest in wanting to wash the dishes and other materials in this space, the operator went into the centre to get soapy water for the children. When children wanted additional scrub brushes, she went back in to get more of these as well.
