## **General Comments**

Licensing staff arrived at the licensed facility to conduct the yearly license renewal inspection.

Child-to-staff ratios were within regulation according to the Early Childhood Services Act throughout the renewal inspection.

The children were freely flowing through the different play areas, and the educators were respecting the maximum classroom size and not exceeding the need to require more than two educators in one play area.

Play activities were set up in each play area were accessible by all children and the children were able to freely roam from one activity to another. One of the activities that licensing staff observed the children engaging in was a science activity consisting of reptile books, glue, lined paper, for the children to write down facts about the reptiles, pictures of the children's drawing of reptiles for the children to re-visit their learning experiences. Another learning activity was a balancing activity consisting of a line placed on the floor, using blue masking tape, for the children to choose items, throughout the classroom, to balance on their head and walk the line without dropping or spilling the items. A third activity consisted of was a cleaning activity using a plastic wash basin, water, facecloths, a old-fashioned, mini, washboard along with a ceramic water jug, to fill and transport from the sink to pour into the wash basin and then pretend to wash the washcloths and after they were finished washing the washcloths they hung them to dry on a drying rack.

While having a conversation with one of the children before going outdoors, a child asked licensing staff if they saw a small table just outside the fenced in playground. Licensing staff told the child that she did see the small table. The child proceeded to tell licensing staff that the table was a "peace table." Licensing staff asked the child what a "peace table" was. The child told licensing staff that "when they have a problem with their friends they go over to the peace table and work out their problem." The child also said, "when they wanted to speak, while at the peace table, they would hold a rose." Licensing staff asked the child what the other child did when they would speak, and the child answered that the other child would listen.

Licensing staff recommends the facility's license to be renewed.
