General Comments
Throughout environments children and educators observed engaged in play and learning. Environments set up with materials neatly displayed and inviting for children.
Respectful and responsive relationships observed between children and educators.
Learning stories posted throughout the learning environments highlight group and individual learning. Consider how you can demonstrate purposeful planning is occurring daily based on the interests of the children.

General Comments

For example, webs, short and long-term projects, materials and books added throughout interest centres.

Recommendations:

- Enhancing the kitchen centre in the infant room with more food, dishes and pots and pans. Educators report that this is an area the babies are enjoying daily.
- Enhancing the dramatic play area in the 3 year old room with costumes, play food, dishes and pots and pans.
- For preschool children who are using the upstairs room as breakout space- ensure a variety of materials are provided to engage children when they are using the space. For example, paint, playdough, collage materials, more games and opportunities for cooperative play. etc.
